

## **Prayer Diary from Monday 1<sup>st</sup> August – God is All-powerful**

*(Firstly, apologies that it's a little late this week – I got caught up with watching the football yesterday evening – Well done to the Lionesses! Phil)*

On Sunday morning Matt focussed us on the fact that God is All-powerful. That there is nothing He cannot do but reflected that all that He does must be true to who He is. That He cannot deny Himself or do anything against His own character.

Because He is all-powerful, we can be assured of our salvation, and that He has the capacity and willingness to do way more, and to give way more that we can ask or even imagine (See Friday)

So, each day ponder the scriptures and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal more of His Power to you and what it means to you. Pray, praise, and give thanks as you feel led.

**Monday:** *Ps 33:6 By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, their starry host by the breath of his mouth.* God called it all into being! How awesome is that!

**Tuesday:** *Col1: 15-16 The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him.* Continue to reflect on the truth of how who he is demonstrates his power.

**Wednesday:** *Col 1: 17-18 He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. <sup>18</sup> And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy.* What amazing truths to reflect on about Him, and what it means for us? Take some time to do that today.

**Thursday:** *Eph 3: 16-17a I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, <sup>17</sup> so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith.* Pray this over yourself, and over others in City Church that he will strengthen and equip us more and more, and that He will dwell in us.

**Friday:** *Eph 3: 20-21 Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, <sup>21</sup> to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.* If he can do more than we can ask OR imagine – dare to ask Him for big things and imagine even bigger things!
