Prayer Diary - Week 2 Promises and Paradigms

There are some crisis moments in our lives where the enemy has a strategic agenda to disappoint, disillusion and disconnect us from our destiny. Moments where we need to remember God's promise and adjust our paradigm to possess it. It's in these moments confronted by our humanity we have the tendency to recess, but when God in His Glory speaks, we are instructed to do the opposite, to rise up and possess. These are "Now Then" moments, what we do *Now* will determine our *Then*. These moments are designed to become movements, as we move from deliverance into inheritance, from promise to possession and from old precepts to a place of reposition.

*Joshua 1v1-3 After the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, the Lord said to Joshua son of Nun, Moses 'aide: 2 Moses my servant is dead. **Now then**, you and all these people, get ready to cross the Jordan River into the land I am about to give to them—to the Israelites. 3 I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses.*

God's promises are subjected to our paradigms and His Power

Everything He is doing, everything you have been praying for, everything He is releasing is dependent on your paradigm changing in four ways:

Monday. Thank the Lord for the promises He has made to you and take some time to write them down again. As you do this begin to praise Him for His promises and declare your promises out loud. (Faith comes by hearing)

Tuesday; Ask the Lord to upgrade your expectation of what is available. Sometimes a long time in the desert can cause us to develop a desert mindset. We want to leave behind any thinking that won't help us possess His blessing.

Wednesday; Moments that become movements always stretch who believe we are. They invite us to an upgraded revelation of who God is for us. However, for the revelation to become a manifestation requires some change to our perceptions of who we are. Ask the Lord to upgrade, refresh and renew how you perceive yourself. God wants you to go large.

Thursday A new season opens up possibilities for new connections because The Lord has assigned relationships that will partner with us into destiny. Pray for discernment regarding these connections and ask for grace to let go of any that can't travel into the future.

Friday. The shift from desert to destiny invites us to a new place of provision. This exciting season is about establishing capacity, it is about who we are becoming. The Lord loves to partner with His people to share His wisdom and expertise and to

cause us to become more like Him. It is a growing into our destiny growing in maturity from Abba to Father in our relationship with God. Pray for capacity for provision, for increase and substance in our walk with God.
